Dates Negotiated for Pacifica's 2014 – 2015 Season

Dates have now been negotiated with the Hillside Church again for Pacifica's 2014-2015 season of play days and events. Please mark you calendars now. Play Day Facility Costs and Performance Opportunity

Our Pacifica Chapter's cost for play day rental facilities at the Hillside Church during the upcoming 2014-2015 season has increased from \$100 per day to \$125 per day for the Saturday 9:00 am to 3:00 pm time period. An opportunity has been presented to us to offset some of this cost increase by occasionally providing music performance services at Hillside Church's fourth Sunday of every month "Hour of Peace" event. A flyer from the Church which describes this monthly event is attached. Each hour that we provide "Hour of Peace" music performance service will offset the \$125 cost of one of our play days. The hour of music could consist of solos, duos, trios, or ensembles pieces in any order and combination.
