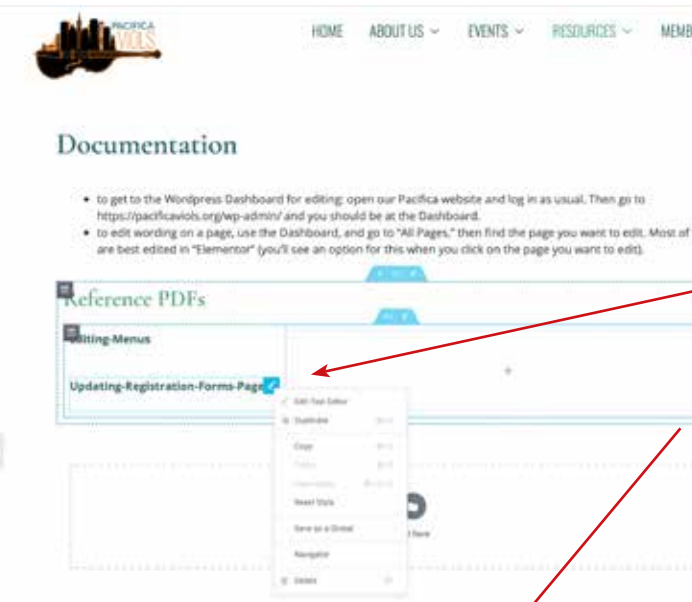


Setting a link to open in a new tab



This example assumes that the link is in a text box; for other types of content like buttons and headings, it's a bit different.

First, find and open the text editor where the link is.

As you roll over the text a box pops up with the link destination. Click the pencil to edit.

New icons will appear: the left one is the "Apply" button, so make sure to click this one when you are done.

The one on the right opens a "Link Options" modal box.

Just click the checkbox that says "Open link in a new tab" and then click the Update button. Back to the link box, click the "Apply" button and don't forget to save the Page (green button at the bottom).
