# Treasurer's Report

It has been an exciting year for Viola da Gamba Pacifica. Below are the totals from our income and expense report. If anyone wishes to see the monthly summary, please let me know. You will find that we overspent our income by \$546.21. There are several reasons for this: we bought \$666 of NEW music this year; our Fresno expenses were higher than expected and our rental income has dropped substantially.


