## February Workshop

Our annual reunion at Stanford will take place on February 5, at Braun Music Center, from 9:30 am to 4 pm. This will be a workshop, coached by John Dornenburg, whose talk this year will be on "Styles in Performance." Workshop fees will be \$15 (\$10 for Pacifica Chapter members.) Please bring your music stand, together with any copies of standard consort repertoire you may possess. Our meetings have been well attended recently, which is splendid news, but has sometimes required doubling of one or two parts, for which a duplicate copy of the music is essential. Please send your reply cards as soon as possible. Lunch will be available on campus at one of the cafeteria, or bring your own.

**Getting there:** from highway 101 N, take the Embarcadero Road exit; from 101 S take University Avenue exit. Proceed west to Campus Drive. Turn left and follow Campus Drive until it becomes Campus Drive EAST. Turn right on Mayfield Avenue and park in the large lot opposite Braun Music Center.

From Highway 280 N exit at Alpine Road, drive east and turn right at Junipero Serra; from 280 S use the Sand Hill Road exit, drive east and take Santa Cruz Avenue (right turn) to Junipero Serra (left turn): in either case, continue on Junipero Serra, ignoring Campus Drive West, and take the left fork onto Campus Drive East. Turn left on Mayfield Avenue to the parking lot.
